

Are you looking for more than an Introductory Flight?

2004 is the year of the 101st Anniversary of powered flight. Why not come and celebrate one of life's great remaining freedoms with us by booking a whole experience with a ☺Celebration Course

Last year, our experienced Flying Club Conington instructors took **over 500 people** flying for the first time in a light aircraft on Introductory Training flights. Many of these wanted to repeat the experience but learn a little more each time. So, by popular request, we have introduced 2 courses to allow **you** to continue with **your** flying. The first course, *Discover YOUR Wings* ☺ is also suitable for those first time flyers who **just know** that aviation is for them!

If you would like to do something a little different for the potential pilot in your life or to treat yourself, Flying Club Conington have put together a special range of ☺**Celebration Courses** due to start on the 101st anniversary of Flight that occurs on December 17th 2004. They would make ideal Christmas presents. We find that more families are looking to find opportunities of clubbing together & buying that really special experience for somebody who has always wanted to fly. Perhaps even combining a Birthday & Christmas present to give them the experience of a lifetime

The first in the ☺**Celebration range** is called *Discover YOUR Wings* ☺

What better way to commemorate that special Birthday or occasion? The course entry requirements are just a tremendous enthusiasm to fly. Although many people will have completed an Introductory flying lesson on the way to discovering this enthusiasm it is not essential.

This course is a fantastic opportunity for a potential pilot to spend at least half a day with us & discover what being a pilot is all about. It is taught on a one to one basis with your personal instructor.

We run these courses during the week so that you can experience a more relaxed atmosphere for your flying & learning & also so that you can experience the radar service provided from RAF Cottesmore that is not available at the week end.

The course allows the pilot to complete **2 hours of flying** during at least two flights from our airfield whilst receiving instruction from one of our experienced instructors & **2 hours with the instructor on the ground**. This will include 15 to 20 minutes covering the pre flight checks on your aircraft & the rest of the time will be spent covering some of the theory of how the aeroplane flies & how **YOU** can make it fly. The course also includes a visit to our Control tower.

The second ☺**Celebration course** is called *Spread YOUR Wings* ☺

So, now you've tried the flying bit ... its time to navigate at the same time! Have you ever wondered how we find the airfield again? Would you like to try it?

This course is for budding pilot/ navigators & you will be able not only to fly the aircraft but also learn how to direct it to where you would like it to go! Again, we run the ☺**Celebration courses** during the week in order to use the radar services of the military airfields. The course entry requirements are usually having carried out an introductory flight – this is only so that you are sure that flying is for you – if you are already convinced, we will be happy with that! Since this course involves **3 hours time in the air** during at least 3 flights & **2 hours of time on the ground with an**

instructor, you may want to spend a whole day with us or perhaps spread the course over two days. These need not be consecutive days.

For your first exercise, you will meet with one of our instructors & together you will check out your aircraft then plan & carry out a local area navigation exercise. The fun is spotting from the air those landmarks that you have already identified on the map during the planning stage in the classroom - & then - finding the airfield again! If you live locally it may be possible to navigate your way to your own house & back via local landmarks.

Your second & third trips need to be on the same day. With your instructor you will plan a trip to a neighbouring airfield (again via local landmarks) & land there for a cup of tea or coffee before you navigate your way back to Conington. During the planning for this trip you will learn about the effect of the wind on the aeroplane & during your flight, you will see how the aeroplane is affected by the wind & how **you** can compensate for it. The course also includes a short visit to our Hangar where you can see the work in progress & admire our smart home based aircraft.

Both 😊 **Celebration courses** are designed for people who have a genuine interest in all aspects of flying & perhaps a desire to get their licence eventually. For this reason, the flights will be properly logged in the log book provided; they will count towards the issue of a licence if the pilot ever decides to continue with training. Both courses will include a cup of tea with a bacon sandwich - or a sandwich of your choice & a 😊 **Celebration course** pilots course completion certificate together with the pilots choice of a small wings badge or a Flying Club Conington Baseball Cap to commemorate the achievement.

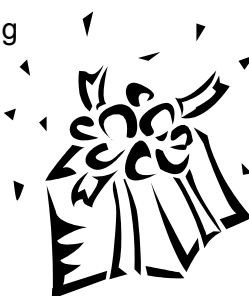
